

65th ZAGREB OPEN INTERNATIONAL JUNIOR & CADET TABLE TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIP

„ZAGIPING“

PROSPECTUS

1. **ORGANIZER:** Zagreb Table Tennis association
2. **TIME AND VENUE OF THE EVENT:** The 65th international Zagreb open table tennis championship for juniors and cadet's – „ZAGIPING“ will be held from the 20.-22.04.2018. in Palace of Sports (Dom Sportova) hall in Zagreb, Trg Krešimira Čosića 11, on 48 tables.
The contest will start on Friday, April 20th at 10:00 a.m. and shall end on Sunday, April 22nd at about 4.00 p.m.
3. **PARTICIPANTS:** The right to participate have all boys and girls born 2000 or younger with the condition that they were registered on time and they pay entry fee.
4. **COMPETITION:**
 - a) The championship will be played on following disciplines:
 - A – JUNIOR BOYS TEAM (born 2000 and younger)
 - B – JUNIOR GIRLS TEAM (born 2000 and younger)
 - C – CADET BOYS TEAM (born 2003 and younger)
 - D – CADET GIRLS TEAM (born 2003 and younger)
 - E – MINI CADET BOYS TEAM (born 2005 and younger)
 - F – MINI CADET GIRLS TEAM (born 2005 and younger)
 - G – MINI MINI CADET BOYS TEAM (born 2007 and younger)
 - H – MINI MINI CADET GIRLS TEAM (born 2007 ang younger)
 - I – JUNIOR BOYS SINGLE (born 2000 and younger)
 - J – JUNIOR GIRLS SINGLE (born 2000 and younger)
 - K – CADET BOYS SINGLE (born 2003 and younger)
 - L – CADET GIRLS SINGLE (born 2003 and younger)
 - M – MINI CADET BOYS SINGLE (born 2005 and younger)
 - N – MINI CADET GIRLS SINGLE(born 2005 and younger)
 - O – MINI MINI CADET BOYS SINGLE (born 2007 and younger)
 - P – MINI MINI CADET GIRLS SINGLE (born 2007 and younger)
 - b) The championship will be played in two stages :
The first stage : **QUALIFICATION** which will be played on Friday the 20th of April.
The second stage : **MAIN EVENT** which will be played on Saturday the 21th and Sunday the 22nd April.
 - c) **THE MAIN EVENT** – there are 16 team and 64 single participants on the main event in each category
 - 8 best ranked teams in each category don't have to go throug the qualification round and they are directly qualified for the main event.
 - 32 best ranked single players in each category don't have to play the qualification round and they are directly qualified for the main event.
 - Team event – 8 teams will qualify from the qualification round to the main event

- Single events – 32 single players will qualify from the qualification round to the main event
- 16 teams in the main event will be placed into 4 groups with 4 teams. The group winners will go through to the semi-final. The match for third place is not played.
- 64 single players in the main event will be placed into 16 groups with 4 players. The first 2 players from each group will continue to the KO system.

d) QUALIFICATION

- all players participate in the qualification round except the 8 best ranked teams and 32 best ranked players in each category
 - teams events - the teams will be drawn and will play in the KO system until we get the best 8 teams for the MAIN EVENT
 - singles events - the players will be drawn in the groups with 3-4 players. From each group the first 2 players will continue to the KO system until we get the best 32 players which will qualified to the main event.
- e) Each club, region or national team has the right to apply an unlimited number of teams and players
- f) Each cadet boy or cadet girl may compete only in one team discipline and one single discipline. A younger player may compete in older category (but not in opposite), however, this should be exactly indicated in Entry Form
- g) The participating players, upon the organizer's request, should (for the purpose of checking the date of birth) show their birth certificate, student identity card or contestant card. Those who will not be able to do shall be excluded from the further contest
- h) The team matches will be played in a 2 against 2 system with doubles (corbillon) until one of the teams makes their 3rd win. The teams play like this: A-X, B-Y, A-Y, B-X, double. In the double's match one, or both of the players who were applied, but didn't play in the single matchup, can play. The players applied for the team on the application **cannot be changed**. In case that one of the players that was applied couldn't come the tournament management can grant his replacement.
- i) All matches played in the team and single events are played on best of five
- j) The time schedule and draw for the tournament will be published on Monday the 16th of April 2018 latest at 22:00 p.m. **on the official web site of CTTA : www.hsts.hr**

5. **AWARDS** : The organizer shall award the sport trophies (cups) to all teams and individual players which are placed from the first to fourth place
6. **ENTRY FORM**: The Entry form shall be sent to the following e-mail address:

7. DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES : Friday, 13th April 2018, at 20:00

This year after the deadline 13th of April 2018, 20:00 p.m. we won't be able to accept your entry without exception.

8. **ENTRY FEE:** The entry fee for this tournament is as follows :

150 kn (20 €) for every team entry

60 kn (8€) for single entry in mini mini cadet event

70 kn (10€) for single entry in mini cadet event

80 kn (11€) for single entry in cadet event

100 kn (13 €) for single entry in junior event

The entry fee shall be payed to the organizires before the start of the tournament for all applied teams and players regardless if they play or no.
