

2017 Polish Junior & Cadet Open
ITTF World Junior Circuit
Golden Series
Wladyslawowo, Poland, 23-28.05.2017

The Polish Table Tennis Federation invites a total of 40 International Umpires to officiate at Polish Junior & Cadet Open – ITTF World Junior Circuit (Golden Series). This tournament is staged in Wladyslawowo – Cetniewo, from Tuesday 23th May to Sunday 28th May 2017.

Wladyslawowo is a town on the south coast of the Baltic Sea in pomeranian region in northern Poland. Wladyslawowo consists of several district, one of them is Cetniewo, Olympic Training Centre.

It's an open invitation. Therefore not all nominations may be accepted. Furthermore, only nominations submitted by national associations or national URC will be considered.

Hospitality

Hospitality is offered from dinner on Tuesday 23th May to breakfast on Monday 29th May 2017. Each umpire will receive a daily allowance of 25 US\$ (22 EURO) per competition day, according to ITTF rules.

Transport

Transport will be provided from and to Lech Walesa Airport in Gdansk. All invited umpires must organize their own transport Wladyslawowo-Cetniewo as well as travel and medical insurance.

Visa Application

Should a nominated umpire require a visa, kindly send scan of passport. A letter of invitation will be provided. Please note that all costs associated with the visa application are the responsibility of the applicant and the issuance of a visa is at the sole discretion of the relevant Consulate or Embassy.

Umpires' uniforms

Umpires must wear the International umpiring uniforms as described in the Handbook for Match Officials.

Deadline

The closing date for nominations is Friday 5th May 2017. The list of umpires accepted will be advised on Monday 8th May 2017.
